It is a Federal project aimed at making this area more of a community. It has a childhood learning center as well.</p> <p>The Giving Tree idea of gift cards will be revisited next September. It lets the parents choose what they want for their children. Parishioners have requested more accessible locations for the tree, such as the altar, the foyer and the parish hall.</p> <p>Bonnie and Tom Owens want to rename the social justice group the Clare-Francis Potluck. Children are welcome to this reorganization meeting that will take place on January 18th from 6:15-9:00 in the Clare Room. They want to discern new goals for serving others in need.</p> <p>St. Andres Bessette was approved a year ago as an official parish ministry. This means they have a line item in our parish general budget. Today they have 30 volunteers. They have \$2400 per year that can be reimbursed.
